

L.I.F.E. Grant

L.I.F.E stands for "Lifting Individuals for Eternity." This grant seeks to reduce the debt of students who desire to rise to higher dimensions in their calling, by granting them a chance to attend a college or seminary. The goal is to lift the mind, motivation and ministry of our students here at Charlotte Christian College and Theological Seminary, preparing them to take Christ to the world.

Reducing Student Loan Debt

By lowering the cost of our tuition for new students we will reduce the amount students need to borrow, resulting in less debt after graduation. The national average for student loan debt for 2016 graduates is \$37,172.

L.I.F.E. Grant – Undergraduate

Tuition Cost: \$476/semester*

*\$476 is based on a student qualifying for full Pell Grant and enrolling full-time (12 hours) in on campus classes. The student will receive a \$1500 tuition reduction for 8 consecutive semesters given they meet below criteria. This grant does not cover the cost of books and fees.

Example of Full-Time Undergraduate student (2018-2019)

Full-Time Tuition (<i>one semester – 12+ hours</i>)	\$5,024
Pell Grant (<i>maximum zero EFC</i>)	- \$3,048
L.I.F.E. Grant (<i>tuition discount</i>)	- \$1,500
Balance Remaining	\$476

Final cost subject to change based on Pell awarded and fees incurred at registration.

L.I.F.E. Grant – Graduate

Tuition Discount: \$1,250/semester*

*\$1,250 is based on a student enrolling full-time (9 hours) each semester. The student will receive a \$1,250 tuition discount for 5 consecutive semesters given they meet certain criteria. This grant does not cover the cost of books and fees.

Example of Full-Time Graduate student (2018-2019)

Full-Time Tuition (<i>one semester – 9 hours</i>)	\$3,834
L.I.F.E. Grant (<i>tuition discount</i>)	-\$1,250
Balance Remaining	\$2,584

Financial Aid is available to all students who complete a FAFSA online.
Final cost subject to change based on fees incurred at registration.

New students applying for Fall 2018 admission qualify for the L.I.F.E Grant. All applicants must submit the following:

1. Submit a completed application online. (CharlotteChristian.edu)
2. Submit all required official transcripts & references. (*Transcripts & references are sent to us directly*)
3. Submit a 2018-2019 FAFSA. (StudentLoans.gov)
